

Facts About Monsoon!!!!!!!

- Monsoon season starts in different time period for different countries like Australia it's monsoon season it it's set between October to April while in India it is between June and September
- The word monsoon is derived from Arabic word "Mausim" It means a shift in season or wind
- In the US, New Mexico, Southwest Texas, and Arizona are all regions with a monsoon season from June 15th to September 30th every year.
- 4. India's very first monsoon forecast was made on 4th June 1886. From 1871 till 2006, the monsoon season has been normal 94 times, with 23 years recorded as droughts.
- 5. In India in the first week of June the monsoon season reaches South India till the mid of June it reaches north India
- Monsoons are caused by the fact that land heats up and cools down quicker than water. Thus, in summer, land reaches a higher temperature than the ocean
- 7. The Monsoon winds starts retreating in the months of October and November because at this time, the Monsoon trough of low pressure over the Ganga Plains becomes weaker due to Southwest movement of the Sun. The low-pressure trough is gradually replaced by high pressure, marking the retreat of the monsoon winds.

Guru Purnima celebration



DIY RAIN GAUGE

Materials:

Empty two-liter plastic bottle Scissors, A few handfuls of clean pebbles, gravel, or marbles Masking tape, Water, Ruler Permanent marker, Rainy weather Paper and pencil

Procedure:

- * Use the scissors to cut the top of the bottle off.
- *Put the pebbles in the bottom of the bottle
- *Turn the top of the bottle upside down —make sure there's no cap on it! It's going to act like a funnel.
- *Use a long piece of tape to make a straight vertical line from the top edge of the bottle to the bottom. Use the marker to draw a line on the vertical piece of tape just a little above the top of the pebbles. This will be the bottom of your rain gauge.
- *leave it in an open area, record the rain per day.



HIGEST RECORD OF RAIN IN THE WORLD

At an aerial distance of 10 km from Cherrapunji, Mawsynram, the wettest place in India, gauged 710.6 mm of rainfall in 24 hours ending 8:30 am Wednesday, the maximum since June 1966. On June 10, 1966, Mawsynram had recorded 717.6 mm of rainfall.

Facts about Rainy Season.

- Rain is one of the six main types of precipitation.
- One droplet of water spends on average around eight days in suspension before falling back to Earth as rain.
- A forest that receives between 98 and 177 inches (2,500 to 4,500 mm) of rain each year is called a rainforest.
- The majority of the Earth's rainforests are found in South America, Africa and Asia.
- 5. Meteorologists can estimate how much it will rain using weather radar.
- Meteorologists can measure the actual amount of rainfall using a rain gauge.
- Small raindrops travel at about 4.5 mph (7.2 km/h), while large raindrops can travel up to 20 mph (32 km/h).
- 8. An average speed of 14mph and an average cloud height of 2,500 feet, it would take two minutes for a raindrop to hit the floor.
- 9. In every minute, one billion tons of rain falls on the earth.
- 10. London and Cambridge are the UK's driest cities.






